Position Title: Mentor/Child Care Assistant

Job Description

We are looking for people that can commit some time with preschool age children to provide a source of consistency, positive guidance, encouragement, support, and motivation. All sites need mentors during the day into the afternoon and early evening. The Head Start Center Coordinator will provide training and orientation. Available sites include:

Time Commitment

Requires a minimum commitment of a 2 –3 hours per week. Must be dependable, as the children count on the support. Volunteers who make a regular commitment of 1 hour or more per week must be able to demonstrate that they are in good health, submit a tuberculosis screening with results, and a police background check.

This opportunity is available to adolescents, adults, and small groups (2 – 10).
