Home foreclosure prevention advice and job opportunities will be part of the free Home Rescue Fair and Career Fair put on by the National Urban League and the Urban League of Metropolitan St. Louis.

The event runs from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday at the Mark Twain Building at the University of Missouri-St. Louis.

Professional development workshops are to be included in the program, which is part of the Urban League's 2009 Economic Empowerment Tour.

Representatives from banks, other financial institutions, housing counseling agencies and legal services will be available for individual sessions with people facing the possibility of home foreclosure.
